Reading

As readers, we will continue to develop our inference, prediction, and summarising skills through a detailed exploration of a range of texts.

Writing

Our first English unit will focus on 'writing to entertain' through our book study 'Beetle Boy' by M G Leonard. We will also be developing our use of formal language to create newspaper articles and information texts. Our creative writing will be further developed by exploring the grammatical skills needed to create powerful, interesting character and setting descriptions.

Mathematics

As mathematicians, we will be developing our understanding of properties of shape, angles, decimals as well as position and direction.

Science

As scientists, we will be learning about animals and living things. Within this, we will analyse and dissect plants as well as explore the human life cycle.

PSHE

As responsible citizens, we will be looking at 'Relationships and Sex Education' and 'Changing Me' which includes body image, influences in the media, puberty and conception.

D & T

As design and technologists, we will be creating a mechanical system 'pop up' book and look at the digital world monitoring devices that are used.

RE

In R.E, we will be building upon our knowledge of Sikhism and Christianity by considering how lessons and morals are applicable to our own lives.

MFL

As Spanish speakers, we will practise and extend our Spanish vocabulary. We will learn about the Spanish culture in Mexico and different sporting events in Spain.

PE

In P.E. our outdoor units will be Tennis and Rounders. We will also visit NSB to complete swimming weekly. We will be building upon fitness, social and strategic thinking skills during these sessions.

Computing

In Computing this term, we will become programmers by looking at selection in quizzes and explore the world of video production.
