

Some games you can play with your child


Number tennis- bat a number to your child, they bat back the number that is 1 more, 2 more, 3 more, 1 less, 2 less 3 less etc

Guess my number- give the child clues e.g. “it is 2 more than 5 (7), 1 more than 10 (11) it has 2 digits, one digit is a long tall straight number, (could be any teen number)

Mystery bag- put your hand inside a bag and describe properties of shapes, e.g. “it has 3 corners”

Beat the timer- turn over an egg timer and start writing numbers from 0 until all the sand runs out. Which number can you get up to? Attempt to get to a higher number next time
