



## Nursery Autumn Term 2023: All About Our Learning



### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children will be happy to separate from their main carer and come into nursery.

As children we will know the class rules

We will be looking at identifying our own feelings.

In our play we will be encouraged to share resources and play in a group, whilst thinking about other people's feelings.

### Physical Development

We will develop our core strength during opportunities both inside and out, such as yoga, balancing and obstacle courses.

We will know how to hop, skip and jump.

We will talk about and make good choices about exercise, healthy eating and the importance of sleep.

We will be exploring large mark making using chalks, paint and water with brushes.

### Literacy

We will start to develop our love of reading.

Children will start to develop their love of reading, by taking part and retelling in early rhymes and stories.

Children will start to recognise their own name.

We will learn how to draw horizontal lines.

### Expressive Art and Design

As artists, we will start to add to our personal sketch books by drawing a self-portrait.

We will use pencils to free draw and start to make observational paintings.

We will learn and perform our favourite songs on our stage area outside.



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### Mathematics

As mathematicians, we will learn number rhymes that involve counting.

We will rote count to 5.

Each day we will explore numbers to 10 as we complete our daily register.

We will sort by colour, size and object.

### Communication and Language

We will listen to fiction books and learn new vocabulary linked with home, family and friends.

We will be sharing and telling new stories. (Helicopter stories)

During our conversations with others, we will be encouraged to answer questions.

### Understanding the World

As historians, we will explore the past and will learn about being a baby and orally share our experiences.

As geographers, we will look at differences and similarities between themselves and other people.

As scientists, we will explore the world around us and discuss and observe the changes over seasons as we explore Autumn in the nursery garden and looking at naming our body parts.

During our outdoor sessions we will ask questions to find out about what we see, hear, smell and touch. In our class we will discuss the daily weather changes that occur. Children will know how materials change when cooking, cooling and heating.

Children will develop an understanding of how and why we celebrate harvest.
