<u>Bridgewater Primary School – Phonics Long Term Plan</u>

Year 2

This plan is a guide. Adapt the plan for the needs of the class and build in time to revise the code that the children need to revisit. Also refer to the Sounds-Write planning documents.

All sessions are based on a 30 mins phonics session. The session should include 3 different Sounds-Write lessons of just under 10 mins each and then a short dictation or reading from text at the end of the session. Sounds-Write is a cumulative programme so continue to practise and build upon everything in previous units.
